## What Did Jesus Say About Zionism?

(Matthew 3:7) But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees come to his baptism, he said unto them, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?

(Matthew 3:8) Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance:

(Matthew 3:9) And think not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to *our* father: for I say unto you, that God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham.

(Matthew 23:33) *Ye serpents, ye generation of vipers, how can ye escape the damnation of hell?*

(Matthew 23:15) *Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte, and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the child of hell than yourselves.*

(Matthew 23:37) *O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, thou that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under *her* wings, and ye would not!*

(Matthew 23:38) *Behold, your house is left unto you desolate.*

(Matthew 21:12) And Jesus went into the temple of God, and cast out all them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves,

(Matthew 21:13) And said unto them, *It is written, My house shall be called the house of prayer; but ye have made it a den of thieves.*

(Matthew 21:19) And when He saw a fig tree in the way, He came to it, and found nothing thereon, but leaves only, and said unto it, *Let no fruit grow on thee henceforward for ever.* And presently the fig tree withered away.

(Acts 1:8) But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto Me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

(Galatians 3:26) For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.

(Galatians 3:27) For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

(Galatians 3:28) There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.

(Galatians 3:29) And if ye *be* Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

(Galatians 3:16) Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed, which is Christ.

(Matthew 21:33) Hear another parable: There was a certain householder, which planted a vineyard, and hedged it round about, and digged a winepress in it, and built a tower, and let it out to husbandmen, and went into a far country:

(Matthew 21:34) And when the time of the fruit drew near, he sent his servants to the husbandmen, that they might receive the fruits of it.

(Matthew 21:35) And the husbandmen took his servants, and beat one, and killed another, and stoned another.

(Matthew 21:36) Again, he sent other servants more than the first: and they did unto them likewise.

(Matthew 21:37) But last of all he sent unto them his son, saying, They will reverence my son.

(Matthew 21:38) But when the husbandmen saw the son, they said among themselves, This is the heir; come, let us kill him, and let us seize on his inheritance.

(Matthew 21:39) And they caught him, and cast *him* out of the vineyard, and slew *him*.

(Matthew 21:40) When the lord therefore of the vineyard cometh, what will he do unto those husbandmen?

(Matthew 21:41) They say unto Him, He will miserably destroy those wicked men, and will let out *his* vineyard unto other husbandmen, which shall render him the fruits in their seasons.

(Matthew 21:42) Jesus saith unto them, Did ye never read in the scriptures, The stone which the builders rejected, the same is become the head of the corner: this is the Lord's doing, and it is marvellous in our eyes?

(Matthew 21:43) Therefore say I unto you, The kingdom of God shall be taken from you, and given to a nation bringing forth the fruits thereof.

(Exodus 19:5) Now therefore, if ye will obey My voice indeed, and keep My covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto Me above all people: for all the earth *is* Mine:

(Exodus 19:6) And ye shall be unto Me a kingdom of priests, and a holy nation. These *are* the words which thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel.

(1 Peter 2:9) But ye *are* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of Him who hath called you out of darkness into His marvellous light:

(Matthew 23:8) But be not ye called Rabbi: for one is your Master, *even* Christ; and all ye are brethren.

(Matthew 23:9) And call no *man* your father upon the earth: for one is your Father, which is in heaven.

(1 Thessalonians 2:15) Who both killed the Lord Jesus, and their own prophets, and have persecuted us; and they please not God, and are contrary to all men:

(Titus 1:12) One of themselves, *even* a prophet of their own, said, The Cretians *are* always liars, evil beasts, slow bellies.

(Luke 13:24) Strive to enter in at the strait gate: for many, I say unto you, will seek to enter in, and shall not be able.

(Luke 13:25) When once the master of the house is risen up, and hath shut to the door, and ye begin to stand without, and to knock at the door, saying, Lord, Lord, open unto us; and He shall answer and say unto you, I know you not whence ye are:

(Luke 13:26) Then shall ye begin to say, We have eaten and drunk in Thy presence, and Thou hast taught in our streets.

(Luke 13:27) But He shall say, I tell you, I know you not whence ye are; depart from Me, all *ye* workers of iniquity.

(Luke 13:28) There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when ye shall see Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets, in the kingdom of God, and you *yourselves* thrust out.

(Genesis 15:18) In the same day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, *Unto thy seed have I given this land, from the river of Egypt unto the great river, the river Euphrates:*

(Joshua 11:23) So Joshua took the whole land, according to all that the LORD said unto Moses; and Joshua gave it for an inheritance unto Israel according to their divisions by their tribes. And the land rested from war.

(Joshua 21:43) And the LORD gave unto Israel all the land which He swore to give unto their fathers; and they possessed it, and dwelt therein.

(Joshua 21:44) And the LORD gave them rest round about, according to all that He swore unto their fathers: and there stood not a man of all their enemies before them; the LORD delivered all their enemies into their hand.

(Numbers 14:12) *I will smite them with the pestilence, and disinherit them, and will make of thee a greater nation and mightier than they.*

(Deuteronomy 28:63) And it shall come to pass, *that* as the LORD rejoiced over you to do you good, and to multiply you; so the LORD will rejoice over you to destroy you, and to bring you to nought; and ye shall be plucked from off the land whither thou goest to possess it.

(Deuteronomy 28:64) And the LORD shall scatter thee among all people, from the one end of the earth even unto the other; and there thou shalt serve other gods, which neither thou nor thy fathers have known, *even* wood and stone.

(Deuteronomy 31:29) For I know that after my death ye will utterly corrupt *yourselves*, and turn aside from the way which I have commanded you; and evil will befall you in the latter days; because ye will do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke Him to anger through the work of your hands.

(Ezekiel 36:24) For I will take you from among the heathen, and gather you out of all countries, and will bring you into your own land.

(Ezekiel 36:25) Then will I sprinkle clean water upon you, and ye shall be clean: from all your filthiness, and from all your idols, will I cleanse you.

(Ezekiel 36:26) A new heart also will I give you, and a new Spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh.

(Ezekiel 36:27) And I will put My Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in My statutes, and ye shall keep My judgments, and do *them*.

(Ezekiel 36:28) And ye shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers; and ye shall be My people, and I will be your God.

(Ezekiel 36:29) I will also save you from all your uncleannesses: and I will call for the corn, and will increase it, and lay no famine upon you.
