The Woman, The Leaven And The Three Measures Of Meal

(Matthew 13:10) And the disciples came, and said unto Him, Why speakest Thou unto them in parables?

(Matthew 13:11) He answered and said unto them, **Because it is given unto you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it is not given.**

(Luke 13:10) And He was teaching in one of the synagogues on the sabbath.

(Luke 13:20) And again He said, **Whereunto shall I liken the kingdom of God?**

(Luke 13:21) **It is like leaven, which a woman took and hid in three measures of meal, till the whole was leavened.**

(Exodus 12:15) **Seven days shall ye eat unleavened bread; even the first day ye shall put away leaven out of your houses: for whosoever eateth leavened bread from the first day until the seventh day, that soul shall be cut off from Israel.**

(Exodus 23:18) Thou shalt not offer the blood of My sacrifice with leavened bread; neither shall the fat of My sacrifice remain until the morning.

(1 Corinthians 5:6) Your glorying *is* not good. Know ye not that a little leaven leaveneth the whole lump?

(1 Corinthians 5:7) Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us:

(1 Corinthians 5:8) Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened *bread* of sincerity and truth.

(Genesis 18:1) And the LORD appeared unto him in the plains of Mamre: and he sat in the tent door in the heat of the day;

(Genesis 18:6) And Abraham hastened into the tent unto Sarah, and said, Make ready quickly three measures of fine meal, knead *it*, and make cakes upon the hearth.

(2 Kings 4:40) So they poured out for the men to eat. And it came to pass, as they were eating of the pottage, that they cried out, and said, O *thou* man of God, *there is* death in the pot. And they could not eat *thereof*.

(2 Kings 4:41) But he said, Then bring meal. And he cast *it* into the pot; and he said, Pour out for the people, that they may eat. And there was no harm in the pot.

(Jeremiah 6:2) **I have likened the daughter of Zion to a comely and delicate woman.**

(Proverbs 7:5) That they may keep thee from the strange woman, from the stranger *which* flattereth with her words.

(Proverbs 7:10) And, behold, there met him a woman *with* the attire of an harlot, and subtil of heart.

(Revelation 17:3) So he carried me away in the Spirit into the wilderness: and I saw a woman sit upon a scarlet coloured beast, full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns.

(Revelation 19:7) Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to Him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and His wife hath made herself ready.

(Luke 13:21) **It is like leaven, which a woman took and hid in three measures of meal, till the whole was leavened.**

(2 Thessalonians 2:3) Let no man deceive you by any means: for *that day shall not come*, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;

(1 Timothy 4:1) Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils;

(2 Timothy 3:1) This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.

(2 Timothy 3:2) For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,

(2 Timothy 3:3) Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good,

(2 Timothy 3:4) Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God;

(2 Timothy 3:5) Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.

(2 Timothy 3:13) But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived.

(Luke 18:8) I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of Man cometh, shall He find faith on the earth?

(John 12:24) Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.

(Matthew 16:6) Then Jesus said unto them, Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.

(Matthew 16:11) How is it that ye do not understand that I spake *it* not to you concerning bread, that ye should beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees?

(Luke 12:1) In the mean time, when there were gathered together an innumerable multitude of people, insomuch that they trode one upon another, He began to say unto His disciples first of all, Beware ye of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.

(Acts 23:8) For the Sadducees say that there is no resurrection, neither angel, nor spirit: but the Pharisees confess both.

(Mark 8:15) And He charged them, saying, Take heed, beware of the leaven of the Pharisees, and of the leaven of Herod.

(Mark 3:6) And the Pharisees went forth, and straightway took counsel with the Herodians against Him, how they might destroy Him.

(1 Corinthians 5:1) It is reported commonly *that there is* fornication among you, and such fornication as is not so much as named among the Gentiles, that one should have his father's wife.

(1 Corinthians 5:2) And ye are puffed up, and have not rather mourned, that he that hath done this deed might be taken away from among you.

(1 Corinthians 5:7) Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us:

(Galatians 5:4) Christ is become of no effect unto you, whosoever of you are justified by the law; ye are fallen from grace.

(Galatians 5:5) For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by faith.

(Galatians 5:6) For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love.

(Galatians 5:7) Ye did run well; who did hinder you that ye should not obey the truth?

(Galatians 5:8) This persuasion *cometh* not of Him that calleth you.

(Galatians 5:9) A little leaven leaveneth the whole lump.

(Leviticus 23:15) *And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the sabbath, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven sabbaths shall be complete:*

(Leviticus 23:16) *Even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath shall ye number fifty days; and ye shall offer a new meat offering unto the LORD.*

(Leviticus 23:17) *Ye shall bring out of your habitations two wave loaves of two tenth deals: they shall be of fine flour; they shall be baked with leaven; they are the firstfruits unto the LORD.*
