The Blessing Of Meekness

(Matthew 5:5) **Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth.**

(2 Peter 3:13) Nevertheless we, according to His promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.

(Isaiah 28:9) Whom shall He teach knowledge? and whom shall He make to understand doctrine? *them that are* weaned from the milk, *and* drawn from the breasts.

(Isaiah 28:10) For precept *must be* upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, *and* there a little:

(Numbers 12:3) (Now the man Moses *was* very meek, above all the men which *were* upon the face of the earth.)

(Exodus 32:19) And it came to pass, as soon as he came nigh unto the camp, that he saw the calf, and the dancing: and Moses' anger waxed hot, and he cast the tables out of his hands, and brake them beneath the mount.

(Exodus 32:20) And he took the calf which they had made, and burnt *it* in the fire, and ground *it* to powder, and strawed *it* upon the water, and made the children of Israel drink *of it*.

(Mark 3:5) And when He had looked round about on them with anger, being grieved for the hardness of their hearts, He saith unto the man, **Stretch forth thine hand.** And he stretched *it* out: and his hand was restored whole as the other.

(Matthew 11:28) **Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.**

(Matthew 21:5) Tell ye the daughter of Sion, Behold, thy King cometh unto thee, meek, and sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of an ass.

(Matthew 21:12) And Jesus went into the temple of God, and cast out all them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves,

(Matthew 21:13) And said unto them, **It is written, My house shall be called the house of prayer; but ye have made it a den of thieves.**

(Ephesians 4:26) Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath:

(Titus 3:2) To speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, *but* gentle, shewing all meekness unto all men.

(Proverbs 15:1) A soft answer turneth away wrath: but grievous words stir up anger.

(Judges 18:8) And they came unto their brethren to Zorah and Eshtaol: and their brethren said unto them, What *say* ye?

(Judges 18:9) And they said, Arise, that we may go up against them: for we have seen the land, and, behold, it *is* very good: and *are* ye still? be not slothful to go, *and* to enter to possess the land.

(Psalms 37:7) Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for him: fret not thyself because of him who prospereth in his way, because of the man who bringeth wicked devices to pass.

(Psalms 37:8) Cease from anger, and forsake wrath: fret not thyself in any wise to do evil.

(Psalms 37:9) For evildoers shall be cut off: but those that wait upon the LORD, they shall inherit the earth.

(Psalms 37:10) For yet a little while, and the wicked *shall* not *be*: yea, thou shalt diligently consider his place, and it *shall* not *be*.

(Psalms 37:11) But the meek shall inherit the earth; and shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace.

(Zephaniah 2:3) Seek ye the LORD, all ye meek of the earth, which have wrought His judgment; seek righteousness, seek meekness: it may be ye shall be hid in the day of the LORD'S anger.

(Colossians 3:12) Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering;

(2 Timothy 2:25) In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth;

(James 1:21) Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.

(Galatians 6:1) Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.

(Psalms 149:4) For the LORD taketh pleasure in His people: He will beautify the meek with salvation.

(Proverbs 22:24) Make no friendship with an angry man; and with a furious man thou shalt not go:

(1 Peter 5:10) But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle *you*.
