Season 3 Episode 18

The Bruised Reed and the Burning Flax

(Matthew 12:18) Behold My servant, whom I have chosen; My beloved, in whom My soul is well pleased: I will put My spirit upon him, and He shall shew judgment to the Gentiles.

(Matthew 12:19) He shall not strive, nor cry; neither shall any man hear His voice in the streets.

(Matthew 12:20) A bruised reed shall He not break, and smoking flax shall He not quench, till He send forth judgment unto victory.

(Isaiah 43:10) Ye *are* My witnesses, saith the LORD, and My servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe Me, and understand that I *am* He: before Me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after Me.

(Isaiah 43:11) I, even I, am the LORD; and beside Me there is no saviour.

(Isaiah 43:12) I have declared, and have saved, and I have shewed, when *there was* no strange *god* among you: therefore ye *are* My witnesses, saith the LORD, that I *am* God.

(John 8:24) I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am *He*, ye shall die in your sins.

(2 Corinthians 4:5) For we preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord; and ourselves your servants for Jesus' sake.

(Galatians 4:19) My little children, of whom I travail in birth again until Christ be formed in you,

(1 Corinthians 11:31) For if we would judge ourselves, we should not be judged.

(1 Corinthians 11:32) But when we are judged, we are chastened of the Lord, that we should not be condemned with the world.

(Philippians 1:6) Being confident of this very thing, that He which hath begun a good work in you will perform *it* until the day of Jesus Christ:

(Romans 7:18) For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me; but *how* to perform that which is good I find not.

(Romans 8:2) For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

(Psalms 31:22) For I said in my haste, I am cut off from before Thine eyes: nevertheless Thou heardest the voice of my supplications when I cried unto Thee.

(Jonah 2:4) Then I said, I am cast out of Thy sight; yet I will look again toward Thy holy temple.

(Hebrews 12:5) And ye have forgotten the exhortation which speaketh unto you as unto children, My son, despise not thou the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when thou art rebuked of Him:

(Hebrews 12:6) For whom the Lord loveth He chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom He receiveth.

(Hebrews 12:8) But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye bastards, and not sons.

(James 4:10) Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He shall lift you up.

(John 6:37) All that the Father giveth Me shall come to Me; and him that cometh to Me I will in no wise cast out.

(John 8:7) So when they continued asking Him, He lifted up Himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her.

(John 8:10) When Jesus had lifted up Himself, and saw none but the woman, He said unto her, Woman, where are those thine accusers? hath no man condemned thee?

(John 8:11) She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.

(Matthew 26:73) And after a while came unto *Him* they that stood by, and said to Peter, Surely thou also art *one* of them; for thy speech bewrayeth thee.

(Matthew 26:74) Then began he to curse and to swear, *saying*, I know not the man. And immediately the cock crew.

(Mark 16:7) But go your way, tell His disciples and Peter that He goeth before you into Galilee: there shall ye see Him, as He said unto you.

(Psalms 73:22) So foolish *was* I, and ignorant: I was *as* a beast before Thee.

(Psalms 73:28) But *it is* good for me to draw near to God: I have put my trust in the Lord GOD, that I may declare all Thy works.

(James 1:14) But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed.

(James 1:15) Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.

(1 John 1:9) If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

(1 John 2:1) My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:

(2 Corinthians 10:4) (For the weapons of our warfare *are* not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)

(2 Corinthians 10:5) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

(James 4:7) Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

(Proverbs 16:3) Commit thy works unto the LORD, and thy thoughts shall be established.

(Galatians 5:13) For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only *use* not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another.

(1 Thessalonians 5:19) Quench not the Spirit.

(Jeremiah 29:11) For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.

(Jeremiah 29:12) Then shall ye call upon Me, and ye shall go and pray unto Me, and I will hearken unto you.

(Jeremiah 29:13) And ye shall seek me, and find *Me*, when ye shall search for Me with all your heart.
