Jesus Is Light Of The World

- (John 8:12) Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth Me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.
- (John 8:44) Ye are of *your* father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.
- (John 1:1) In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- (John 1:2) The same was in the beginning with God.
- (John 1:3) All things were made by Him; and without Him was not any thing made that was made.
- (John 1:4) In Him was life; and the life was the light of men.
- (John 1:5) And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.
- (John 1:6) There was a man sent from God, whose name was John.
- (John 1:7) The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all *men* through Him might believe.
- (John 1:8) He was not that Light, but was sent to bear witness of that Light.
- (John 1:9) That was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world.
- (John 3:19) And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.

(John 12:47) And if any man hear My words, and believe not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world.

(John 12:48) He that rejecteth Me, and receiveth not My words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day.

(Matthew 6:22) The light of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light.

(Matthew 6:23) But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great *is* that darkness!

(2 Corinthians 11:13) For such *are* false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ.

(2 Corinthians 11:14) And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.

(Matthew 5:14) Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid.

(Matthew 5:15) Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house.

(Matthew 5:16) Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

(Gospel of Thomas 1:24) His disciples said, "Show us the place where you are, for we must seek it".

(Isaiah 14:17 NIV) the man who made the world a wilderness, who overthrew the cities and would not let his captives go home?

(Revelation 22:16) I Jesus have sent Mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, and the Bright and Morning Star.

(Psalms 104:2) Who coverest *Thyself* with light as *with* a garment: who stretchest out the heavens like a curtain:

(1 Timothy 6:15) Which in His times He shall shew, who is the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings, and Lord of lords;

- (1 Timothy 6:16) Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom *be* honour and power everlasting. Amen.
- (Matthew 17:1) And after six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and bringeth them up into an high mountain apart,
- (Matthew 17:2) And was transfigured before them: and His face did shine as the sun, and His raiment was white as the light.
- (John 1:14) And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.
- (Acts 9:3) And as he journeyed, he came near Damascus: and suddenly there shined round about him a light from heaven:
- (Revelation 1:14) His head and *His* hairs *were* white like wool, as white as snow; and His eyes *were* as a flame of fire;
- (Revelation 1:15) And His feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and His voice as the sound of many waters.
- (Amos 5:18) Woe unto you that desire the day of the LORD! to what end is it for you? the day of the LORD is darkness, and not light.
- (1 Thessalonians 5:1) But of the times and the seasons, brethren, ye have no need that I write unto you.
- (1 Thessalonians 5:2) For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so cometh as a thief in the night.
- (1 Thessalonians 5:3) For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape.
- (1 Thessalonians 5:4) But ye, brethren, are not in darkness, that that day should overtake you as a thief.

The Doctrine of Christ Season 4 Episode 19

(1 Thessalonians 5:5) Ye are all the children of light, and the children of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness.

- (2 Thessalonians 2:8) And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of His mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of His coming:
- (Zechariah 14:12) And this shall be the plague wherewith the LORD will smite all the people that have fought against Jerusalem; Their flesh shall consume away while they stand upon their feet, and their eyes shall consume away in their holes, and their tongue shall consume away in their mouth.
- (Ephesians 5:14) Wherefore He saith, Awake thou that sleepest, and arise from the dead, and Christ shall give thee light.
- (Ephesians 2:1) And you hath He quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins;
- (Psalms 119:105) NUN. Thy word *is* a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.
- (1 John 1:6) If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth:
- (1 John 1:7) But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanseth us from all sin.
- (1 John 2:4) He that saith, I know Him, and keepeth not His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.
