

## Season 5 Episode 3

### The Second Commandment

(Exodus 20:4) Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that *is* in heaven above, or that *is* in the earth beneath, or that *is* in the water under the earth:

(Exodus 20:5) Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God *am* a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth *generation* of them that hate Me;

(Exodus 20:6) And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love Me, and keep My commandments.

(John 4:23) But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.

(John 4:24) God *is* a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship *Him* in spirit and in truth.

(Deuteronomy 4:15) Take ye therefore good heed unto yourselves; for ye saw no manner of similitude on the day *that* the LORD spake unto you in Horeb out of the midst of the fire:

(Deuteronomy 4:16) Lest ye corrupt *yourselves*, and make you a graven image, the similitude of any figure, the likeness of male or female,

(Acts 17:29) Forasmuch then as we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the Godhead is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven by art and man's device.

(Colossians 2:22) Which all are to perish with the using;) after the commandments and doctrines of men?

(Colossians 2:23) Which things have indeed a shew of wisdom in will worship, and humility, and neglecting of the body; not in any honour to the satisfying of the flesh.

(Isaiah 42:13) The LORD shall go forth as a mighty man, He shall stir up jealousy like a man of war: He shall cry, yea, roar; He shall prevail against His enemies.

(Hebrews 10:31) *It is* a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.

(Ezekiel 18:19) Yet say ye, Why? doth not the son bear the iniquity of the father? When the son hath done that which is lawful and right, *and* hath kept all My statutes, and hath done them, he shall surely live.

(Ezekiel 18:20) The soul that sinneth, it shall die. The son shall not bear the iniquity of the father, neither shall the father bear the iniquity of the son: the righteousness of the righteous shall be upon him, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon him.

(Isaiah 43:24) Thou hast bought Me no sweet cane with money, neither hast thou filled Me with the fat of thy sacrifices: but thou hast made Me to serve with thy sins, thou hast wearied Me with thine iniquities.

(Psalms 32:5) I acknowledged my sin unto Thee, and mine iniquity have I not hid. I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the LORD; and Thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin. Selah.

(Lamentations 2:14) Thy prophets have seen vain and foolish things for thee: and they have not discovered thine iniquity, to turn away thy captivity; but have seen for thee false burdens and causes of banishment.

(Leviticus 16:7) And he shall take the two goats, and present them before the LORD *at* the door of the tabernacle of the congregation.

(Leviticus 16:11) And Aaron shall bring the bullock of the sin offering, which *is* for himself, and shall make an atonement for himself, and for his house, and shall kill the bullock of the sin offering which *is* for himself:

(Leviticus 16:21) And Aaron shall lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat, and confess over him all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions in all their sins, putting them upon the head of the goat, and shall send *him* away by the hand of a fit man into the wilderness:

(1 John 1:9) If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

(Luke 3:16) John answered, saying unto *them* all, I indeed baptize you with water; but one mightier than I cometh, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose: He shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire:

(Luke 3:17) Whose fan *is* in His hand, and He will thoroughly purge His floor, and will gather the wheat into His garner; but the chaff He will burn with fire unquenchable.

(Romans 7:18) For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me; but *how* to perform that which is good I find not.

(Romans 8:2) For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

(Numbers 21:8) And the LORD said unto Moses, **Make thee a fiery serpent, and set it upon a pole: and it shall come to pass, that every one that is bitten, when he looketh upon it, shall live.**

(Numbers 21:9) And Moses made a serpent of brass, and put it upon a pole, and it came to pass, that if a serpent had bitten any man, when he beheld the serpent of brass, he lived.

(2 Kings 18:4) He removed the high places, and brake the images, and cut down the groves, and brake in pieces the brasen serpent that Moses had made: for unto those days the children of Israel did burn incense to it: and he called it Nehushtan.

(John 3:14) **And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up:**

(John 3:15) **That whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have eternal life.**

(Isaiah 27:1) In that day the LORD with His sore and great and strong sword shall punish leviathan the piercing serpent, even leviathan that crooked serpent; and He shall slay the dragon that *is* in the sea.

(Job 41:15) **His scales are his pride, shut up together as *with* a close seal.**

(Job 41:16) One is so near to another, that no air can come between them.

(Job 41:17) They are joined one to another, they stick together, that they cannot be sundered.

(Job 41:18) By his sneezings a light doth shine, and his eyes *are* like the eyelids of the morning.

(Job 41:19) Out of his mouth go burning lamps, *and* sparks of fire leap out.

(Job 41:20) Out of his nostrils goeth smoke, as *out* of a seething pot or caldron.

(Job 41:21) His breath kindleth coals, and a flame goeth out of his mouth.

(Psalms 106:37) Yea, they sacrificed their sons and their daughters unto devils,

(Psalms 106:38) And shed innocent blood, *even* the blood of their sons and of their daughters, whom they sacrificed unto the idols of Canaan: and the land was polluted with blood.

(Psalms 106:39) Thus were they defiled with their own works, and went a whoring with their own inventions.

(1 Corinthians 10:19) What say I then? that the idol is any thing, or that which is offered in sacrifice to idols is any thing.

(1 Corinthians 10:20) But *I say*, that the things which the Gentiles sacrifice, they sacrifice to devils, and not to God: and I would not that ye should have fellowship with devils.

(Revelation 22:14) Blessed *are* they that do His commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

(Revelation 22:15) For without *are* dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loveth and maketh a lie.

(Revelation 21:8) But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.
