## The 4th Commandment: Remember The Sabbath

### Season 5 Episode 5

**Exodus 20:8** Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy.

**Exodus 20:9** Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work:

**Exodus 20:10** But the seventh day *is* the sabbath of the LORD thy God: *in it* thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that *is* within thy gates:

**Genesis 2:1** Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them.

**Genesis 2:2** And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made.

**Genesis 2:3** And God blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God created and made.

**Exodus 16:16** This *is* the thing which the LORD hath commanded, Gather of it every man according to his eating, an omer for every man, *according to* the number of your persons; take ye every man for *them* which *are* in his tents.

**Exodus 16:19** And Moses said, Let no man leave of it till the morning.

**Exodus 16:20** Notwithstanding they hearkened not unto Moses; but some of them left of it until the morning, and it bred worms, and stank: and Moses was wroth with them.

**Exodus 16:21** And they gathered it every morning, every man according to his eating: and when the sun waxed hot, it melted.

**Exodus 16:22** And it came to pass, *that* on the sixth day they gathered twice as much bread, two omers for one *man*: and all the rulers of the congregation came and told Moses.

**Exodus 16:23** And he said unto them, This *is that* which the LORD hath said, To morrow *is* the rest of the holy sabbath unto the LORD: bake *that* which ye will bake *to day*, and see the that ye will see the; and that which remaineth over lay up for you to be kept until the morning.

**Exodus 16:24** And they laid it up till the morning, as Moses bade: and it did not stink, neither was there any worm therein.

**Exodus 16:25** And Moses said, Eat that to day; for to day *is* a sabbath unto the LORD: to day ye shall not find it in the field.

**Exodus 16:26** Six days ye shall gather it; but on the seventh day, *which is* the sabbath, in it there shall be none.

**Matthew 28:1** In the end of the sabbath, as it began to dawn toward the first *day* of the week, came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to see the sepulchre.

**2 Corinthians 11:3** But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.

**1 Peter 2:21** For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps:

**Genesis 1:3** And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.

**Genesis 1:4** And God saw the light, that *it was* good: and God divided the light from the darkness.

**Genesis 1:5** And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day.

**Deuteronomy 16:6** But at the place which the LORD thy God shall choose to place his name in, there thou shalt sacrifice the passover at even, at the going down of the sun, at the season that thou camest forth out of Egypt.

**Exodus 35:3** Ye shall kindle no fire throughout your habitations upon the sabbath day.

**Mark 2:27** And he said unto them, **The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath:**

**Mark 3:1** And he entered again into the synagogue; and there was a man there which had a withered hand.

**Mark 3:2** And they watched him, whether he would heal him on the sabbath day; that they might accuse him.

**Mark 3:3** And he saith unto the man which had the withered hand, **Stand forth.**

**Mark 3:4** And he saith unto them, **Is it lawful to do good on the sabbath days, or to do evil? to save life, or to kill?** But they held their peace.

**Mark 3:5** And when he had looked round about on them with anger, being grieved for the hardness of their hearts, he saith unto the man, **Stretch forth thine hand**. And he stretched *it* out: and his hand was restored whole as the other.

**Mark 3:6** And the Pharisees went forth, and straightway took counsel with the Herodians against him, how they might destroy him.

**Isaiah 58:13** If thou turn away thy foot from the sabbath, *from* doing thy pleasure on my holy day; and call the sabbath a delight, the holy of the LORD, honourable; and shalt honour him, not doing thine own ways, nor finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking *thine own* words:

**Isaiah 58:14** Then shalt thou delight thyself in the LORD; and I will cause thee to ride upon the high places of the earth, and feed thee with the heritage of Jacob thy father: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken *it*.

**Mark 2:28** **Therefore the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath.**

**Luke 23:52** This *man* went unto Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus.

**Luke 23:53** And he took it down, and wrapped it in linen, and laid it in a sepulchre that was hewn in stone, wherein never man before was laid.

**Luke 23:54** And that day was the preparation, and the sabbath drew on.

**Luke 23:55** And the women also, which came with him from Galilee, followed after, and beheld the sepulchre, and how his body was laid.

**Luke 23:56** And they returned, and prepared spices and ointments; and rested the sabbath day according to the commandment.

**Luke 4:16** And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and stood up for to read.

**Luke 23:54** And that day was the preparation, and the sabbath drew on.

**Luke 13:10** And he was teaching in one of the synagogues on the sabbath.

**Luke 13:11** And, behold, there was a woman which had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up *herself*.

**Luke 13:12** And when Jesus saw her, he called *her to him*, and said unto her, **Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity.**

**Luke 13:13** And he laid *his* hands on her: and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.

**Luke 13:14** And the ruler of the synagogue answered with indignation, because that Jesus had healed on the sabbath day, and said unto the people, There are six days in which men ought to work: in them therefore come and be healed, and not on the sabbath day.

**Luke 13:15** The Lord then answered him, and said, ***Thou hypocrite, doth not each one of you on the sabbath loose his ox or his ass from the stall, and lead him away to watering?***

**Luke 13:16** **And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day?**

**Luke 13:17** And when he had said these things, all his adversaries were ashamed: and all the people rejoiced for all the glorious things that were done by him.

**Exodus 23:12** Six days thou shalt do thy work, and on the seventh day thou shalt rest: that thine ox and thine ass may rest, and the son of thy handmaid, and the stranger, may be refreshed.

**Hebrews 4:3** For we which have believed do enter into rest, as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into my rest: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.

**Hebrews 4:9** There remaineth therefore a rest to the people of God.

**Hebrews 4:10** For he that is entered into his rest, he also hath ceased from his own works, as God *did* from his.

**Hebrews 4:11** Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief.

**Colossians 2:16** Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath *days*:

**Colossians 2:17** Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body *is* of Christ.

**Colossians 2:22** Which all are to perish with the using;) after the commandments and doctrines of men?

**Luke 4:16** And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and stood up for to read.

**Luke 4:17** And there was delivered unto him the book of the prophet Esaias. And when he had opened the book, he found the place where it was written,

**Luke 4:18** The Spirit of the Lord *is* upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

**Luke 4:19** To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.

**Isaiah 61:1** The Spirit of the Lord GOD *is* upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to *them that are* bound;

**Isaiah 61:2** To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn;

**Daniel 9:27** And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make *it* desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

**Luke 17:22** And he said unto the disciples, **The days will come, when ye shall desire to see one of the days of the Son of man, and ye shall not see *it*.**

**Luke 17:23** **And they shall say to you, See here; or, see there: go not after *them*, nor follow *them*.**

**Luke 17:24** For as the lightning, that lighteneth out of the one *part* under heaven, shineth unto the other *part* under heaven; so shall also the Son of man be in his day.

**Luke 17:25** But first must he suffer many things, and be rejected of this generation.

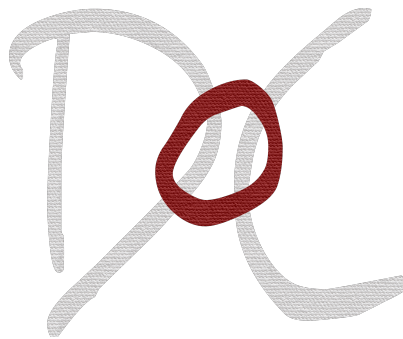
**Luke 17:26** And as it was in the days of Noe, so shall it be also in the days of the Son of man.

**Luke 17:27** They did eat, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, and the flood came, and destroyed them all.

**Luke 17:28** Likewise also as it was in the days of Lot; they did eat, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they builded;

**Luke 17:29** But the same day that Lot went out of Sodom it rained fire and brimstone from heaven, and destroyed *them* all.

**Luke 17:30** Even thus shall it be in the day when the Son of man is revealed.
