## The Attributes: The Holiness of God

### Season 6 Episode 2

“Which of you convinceth me of sin? And if I say the truth, why do ye not believe me?” (**John 8:46**)

“Who *is* like unto thee, O LORD, among the gods? who *is* like thee, glorious in holiness, fearful *in* praises, doing wonders?”  
(**Exodus 15:11**)

“And I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvellous, seven angels having the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God.” (**Revelation 15:1**)

“And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, *and* over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God.” (**Revelation 15:2**)

“And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvellous *are* thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true *are* thy ways, thou King of saints.”  
(**Revelation 15:3**)

“And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,” (**Leviticus 19:1**)

“Speak unto all the congregation of the children of Israel, and say unto them, Ye shall be holy: for I the LORD your God *am* holy.” (**Leviticus 19:2**)

“But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation;” (**1 Peter 1:15**)

“Follow peace with all *men*, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:” (**Hebrews 12:14**)

“*There is* none holy as the LORD: for *there is* none beside thee: neither *is there* any rock like our God.” (**1 Samuel 2:2**)

“Whom hast thou reproached and blasphemed? and against whom hast thou exalted *thy* voice, and lifted up thine eyes on high? *even* against the Holy *One* of Israel.” (**2 Kings 19:22**)

“And the four beasts had each of them six wings about *him*; and *they were* full of eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come.” (**Revelation 4:8**)

“In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple.” (**Isaiah 6:1**)

“And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, *is* the LORD of hosts: the whole earth *is* full of his glory.” (**Isaiah 6:3**)

“Then said I, Woe *is* me! for I am undone; because I *am* a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: for mine eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts.” (**Isaiah 6:5**)

“Wherefore the law *is* holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good.” (**Romans 7:12**)

“The statutes of the LORD *are* right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the LORD *is* pure, enlightening the eyes.” (**Psalms 19:8**)

“The words of the LORD *are* pure words: *as* silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times.” (**Psalms 12:6**)

“Thou shalt keep them, O LORD, thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever.” (**Psalms 12:7**)

“*Thou art* of purer eyes than to behold evil, and canst not look on iniquity: wherefore lookest thou upon them that deal treacherously, *and* holdest thy tongue when the wicked devoureth *the man that is* more righteous than he?” (**Habakkuk 1:13**)

“I hate, I despise your feast days, and I will not smell in your solemn assemblies.” (**Amos 5:21**)

“Though ye offer me burnt offerings and your meat offerings, I will not accept *them*: neither will I regard the peace offerings of your fat beasts.” (**Amos 5:22**)

“Take thou away from me the noise of thy songs; for I will not hear the melody of thy viols.” (**Amos 5:23**)

“Your new moons and your appointed feasts my soul hateth: they are a trouble unto me; I am weary to bear *them*.” (**Isaiah 1:14**)

“Howbeit I sent unto you all my servants the prophets, rising early and sending *them*, saying, Oh, do not this abominable thing that I hate.” (**Jeremiah 44:4**)

“*As for* the word that thou hast spoken unto us in the name of the LORD, we will not hearken unto thee.” (**Jeremiah 44:16**)

“But we will certainly do whatsoever thing goeth forth out of our own mouth, to burn incense unto the queen of heaven, and to pour out drink offerings unto her, as we have done, we, and our fathers, our kings, and our princes, in the cities of Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem: for *then* had we plenty of victuals, and were well, and saw no evil.” (**Jeremiah 44:17**)

“But they rebelled, and vexed his holy Spirit: therefore he was turned to be their enemy, *and* he fought against them.” (**Isaiah 63:10**)

“God judgeth the righteous, and God is angry *with the wicked* every day.” (**Psalms 7:11**)

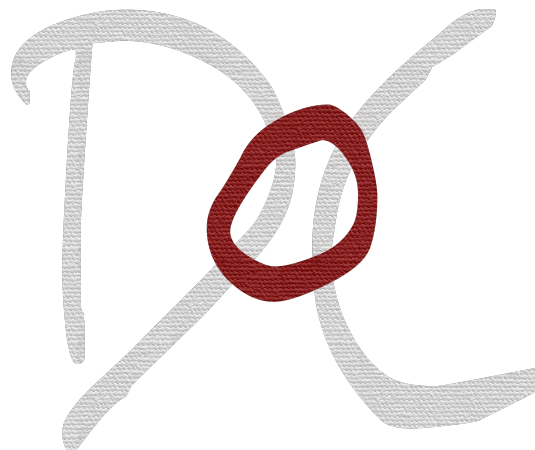
“The fear of the LORD *is* clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD *are* true *and* righteous altogether.” (**Psalms 19:9**)
