(1 Peter 1:8)

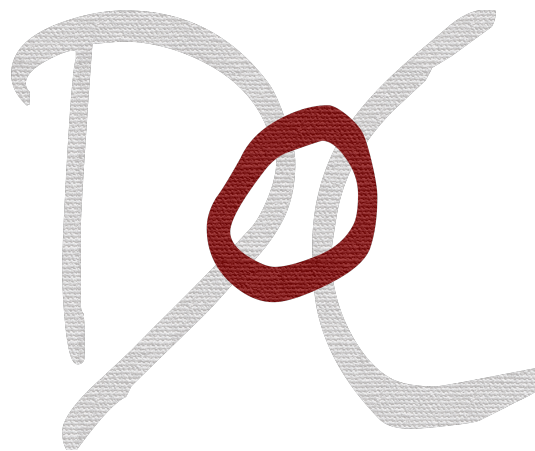
“Commit thy works unto the LORD, and thy thoughts shall be established.” **(Proverbs 16:3)**
