“But Jesus did not commit himself unto them, because he knew all *men*,” (**John 2:24**)

“Thou knowest my downsitting and mine uprising, thou understandest my thought afar off.”  
(**Psalms 139:2**)

“Thou compassest my path and my lying down, and art acquainted *with* all my ways.”  
(**Psalms 139:3**)

“For *there is* not a word in my tongue, *but*, lo, O LORD, thou knowest it altogether.”  
(**Psalms 139:4**)

“Great *is* our Lord, and of great power: his understanding *is* infinite.”  
(**Psalms 147:5**)

“Talk no more so exceeding proudly; let *not* arrogancy come out of your mouth: for the LORD *is* a God of knowledge, and by him actions are weighed.”  
(**1 Samuel 2:3**)

“My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children.”  
(**Hosea 4:6**)

“But grow in grace, and *in* the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To him *be* glory both now and for ever. Amen.”

**(2 Peter 3:18)**

“Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.”

**(2 Timothy 2:15)**

“But shun profane *and* vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness.”

**(2 Timothy 2:16)**

“And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.”

**(2 Thessalonians 2:10)**

“For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water:”

**(2 Peter 3:5)**

“Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, to the strangers scattered throughout Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia,”

“Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times *the things* that are not *yet* done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure:”

**(Isaiah 46:10)**

“For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.” **(Isaiah 9:6)**

“Then answered Jesus and said unto them, *Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.*”

**(John 5:19)**

“For the Father loveth the Son, and sheweth him all things that himself doeth: and he will shew him greater works than these, that ye may marvel.”

“Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.”

**(John 14:10)**

“Wilt thou hunt the prey for the lion? or fill the appetite of the young lions,”

**(Job 38:39)**

“When they couch in *their* dens, *and* abide in the covert to lie in wait?”

**(Job 38:40)**

“Who provideth for the raven his food? when his young ones cry unto God, they wander for lack of meat.” **(Job 38:41)**

“Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment?”

**(Matthew 6:25)**

“Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they?”

**(Matthew 6:26)**

“Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature?”

**(Matthew 6:27)**

“And yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.”

**(Matthew 6:29)**

“Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, *shall he* not much more *clothe* you, O ye of little faith?”

**(Matthew 6:30)**

“Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed?”

**(Matthew 6:31)**

“But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.”

**(Matthew 6:33)**

“And a *certain* man drew a bow at a venture, and smote the king of Israel between the joints of the harness: wherefore he said unto the driver of his chariot, Turn thine hand, and carry me out of the host; for I am wounded.”

**(1 Kings 22:34)**

“Known unto God are all his works from the beginning of the world.”  
(Acts 15:18)

“For my thoughts *are* not your thoughts, neither *are* your ways my ways, saith the LORD.”  
(Isaiah 55:8)

“For *as* the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.”  
(Isaiah 55:9)

“O the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! how unsearchable *are* his judgments, and his ways past finding out!”

“But the very hairs of your head are all numbered.”

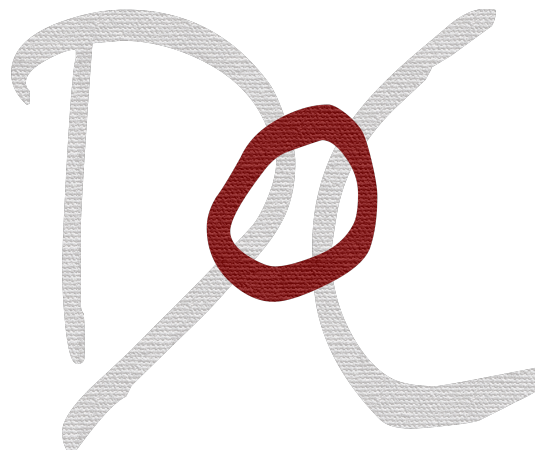
**(Matthew 10:30)**
