The Attributes: The Mercy of God

“Grace *be* to you and peace from God our Father, and *from* the Lord Jesus Christ.”

(2 Corinthians 1:2)

“Blessed *be* God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort;”

(2 Corinthians 1:3)

“And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth,”

(Exodus 34:6)

“Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear *the guilty*; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth *generation*.”

“For thy mercy *is* great unto the heavens, and thy truth unto the clouds.”

(Psalms 57:10)

“Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies;”

(Psalms 103:4)

“Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.”

(Hebrews 4:16)

“And he shall take of the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle *it* with his finger upon the mercy seat eastward; and before the mercy seat shall he sprinkle of the blood with his finger seven times.”

“And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.”

“And your threshing shall reach unto the vintage, and the vintage shall reach unto the sowing time: and ye shall eat your bread to the full, and dwell in your land safely.”

“And I will give peace in the land, and ye shall lie down, and none shall make *you* afraid: and I will rid evil beasts out of the land, neither shall the sword go through your land.”

“And I will walk among you, and will be your God, and ye shall be my people.” (Leviticus 26:12) “Who *is* a God like unto thee, that pardoneth iniquity, and passeth by the transgression of the remnant of his heritage? he retaineth not his anger for ever, because he delighteth *in* mercy.”

(Micah 7:18)

“Thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel, unto thee, O Baruch;”

(Jeremiah 45:2)

“Thou didst say, Woe is me now! for the LORD hath added grief to my sorrow; I fainted in my sighing, and I find no rest.”

(Jeremiah 45:3)

“Thus shalt thou say unto him, The LORD saith thus; Behold, *that* which I have built will I break down, and that which I have planted I will pluck up, even this whole land.”

(Jeremiah 45:4)

“And seekest thou great things for thyself? seek *them* not: for, behold, I will bring evil upon all flesh, saith the LORD: but thy life will I give unto thee for a prey in all places whither thou goest.”

(Jeremiah 45:5)

“But I *am* like a green olive tree in the house of God: I trust in the mercy of God for ever and ever.”

(Psalms 52:8)

“O give thanks unto the LORD; for *he is* good: for his mercy *endureth* for ever.”

(Psalms 136:1)

“If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”

(1 John 1:9)

“But they and our fathers dealt proudly, and hardened their necks, and hearkened not to thy commandments,”

(Nehemiah 9:16)

“And refused to obey, neither were mindful of thy wonders that thou didst among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion appointed a captain to return to their bondage: but thou *art* a God ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and forsookest them not.”

(Nehemiah 9:17)

“I will heal their backsliding, I will love them freely: for mine anger is turned away from him.”

(Hosea 14:4)

“Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:”

(Romans 3:24)

“Whom God hath set forth *to be* a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;”

(Romans 3:25)

“Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;”

(Titus 3:5)

“And he said, I beseech thee, shew me thy glory.”
(Exodus 33:18)

“And he said, I will make all my goodness pass before thee, and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before thee; and will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will shew mercy on whom I will shew mercy.”
(Exodus 33:19)

“And he said, Thou canst not see my face: for there shall no man see me, and live.”
(Exodus 33:20)

“And the LORD said, Behold, *there is* a place by me, and thou shalt stand upon a rock:”
(Exodus 33:21)

“And it shall come to pass, while my glory passeth by, that I will put thee in a clift of the rock, and will cover thee with my hand while I pass by:”
(Exodus 33:22)

“And I will take away mine hand, and thou shalt see my back parts: but my face shall not be seen.”
(Exodus 33:23)

“And thou shalt put the mercy seat above upon the ark; and in the ark thou shalt put the testimony that I shall give thee.”
(Exodus 25:21)

“And there I will meet with thee, and I will commune with thee from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubims which *are* upon the ark of the testimony, of all *things* which I will give thee in commandment unto the children of Israel.”

“For he doth not afflict willingly nor grieve the children of men.”

“So speak ye, and so do, as they that shall be judged by the law of liberty.” (**James 2:12**)

“For he shall have judgment without mercy, that hath shewed no mercy; and mercy rejoiceth against judgment.”

(**Job 35:10**)

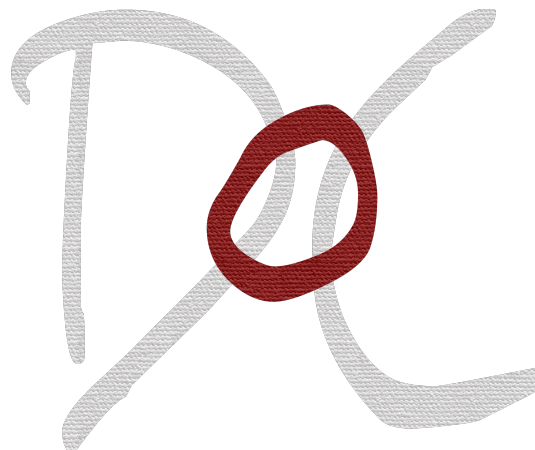
