(**Numbers 6:23**)

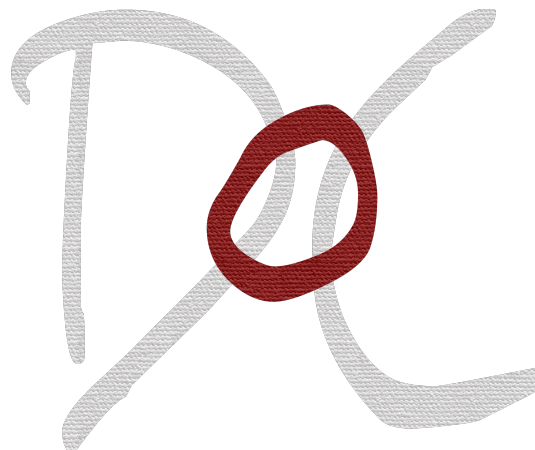
“The LORD bless thee, and keep thee:”
