It's a Blood Covenant

Season 7 Episode 1

Matthew 26:27

27 And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave *it* to them, saying, **Drink ye all of it;**

Matthew 26:28

28 For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.

Matthew 8:11

11 And I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom of heaven.

Daniel 9:27

27 And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make *it* desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

Jeremiah 31:31

31 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah:

Jeremiah 31:32

32 Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day *that* I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which my covenant they brake, although I was an husband unto them, saith the LORD:

Hebrews 8:7

7 For if that first *covenant* had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second.

Hebrews 8:8

8 For finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah:

Hebrews 8:5

5 Who serve unto the example and shadow of heavenly things, as Moses was admonished of God when he was about to make the tabernacle: for, See, saith he, *that* thou make all things according to the pattern shewed to thee in the mount.

Hebrews 8:6

6 But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises.

Genesis 3:15

15 And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

Colossians 2:14

14 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

Colossians 2:15

15 *And* having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.

Genesis 3:21

21 Unto Adam also and to his wife did the LORD God make coats of skins, and clothed them.

Leviticus 1:3

3 If his offering *be* a burnt sacrifice of the herd, let him offer a male without blemish: he shall offer it of his own voluntary will at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation before the LORD.

Leviticus 1:4

4 And he shall put his hand upon the head of the burnt offering; and it shall be accepted for him to make atonement for him.

Genesis 4:3

3 And in process of time it came to pass, that Cain brought of the fruit of the ground an offering unto the LORD.

Genesis 4:4

4 And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of the fat thereof. And the LORD had respect unto Abel and to his offering:

Hebrews 11:4

4 By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts: and by it he being dead yet speaketh.

Hebrews 9:22

22 And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.

Hebrews 10:4

4 For *it is* not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.

Psalms 103:12

12 As far as the east is from the west, *so* far hath he removed our transgressions from us.

Psalms 103:13

13 Like as a father pitieth *his* children, *so* the LORD pitieth them that fear him.

Psalms 51:2

2 Wash me thoroughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin.

Exodus 26:1

1 Moreover thou shalt make the tabernacle *with* ten curtains *of* fine twined linen, and blue, and purple, and scarlet: *with* cherubims of cunning work shalt thou make them.

Genesis 4:6

6 And the LORD said unto Cain, Why art thou wroth? and why is thy countenance fallen?

Genesis 4:7

7 If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? and if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee *shall be* his desire, and thou shalt rule over him.

2 Corinthians 5:21

21 For he hath made him *to be* sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

Adam and Eve 36

And Adam said to Eve: " Rise up and go with my son Seth to the neighborhood of paradise, and put dust on your heads and throw yourselves on the ground and lament in the sight of God. Perchance He will have pity upon you and send His angel across to the tree of His mercy, whence floweth the oil of life, and will give you a drop of it, to anoint me with it, that I may have rest from these pains, by which I am being consumed."

Adam and Eve 37

Then Seth and his mother went off toward the gates of paradise. And while they were walking, lo! suddenly there came a beast (a serpent) and attacked and bit Seth. And as soon as Eve saw it, she wept and said: " Alas, wretched woman that I am. I am accursed since I have not kept the commandment of God."

Adam and Eve 40

But Seth and his mother walked to the regions of paradise for the oil of mercy to anoint the sick Adam: and they arrived at the gates of paradise, and they took dust from the earth and placed it on their heads, and bowed themselves with their faces to the earth, and began to lament.

Exodus 24:7

7 And he took the book of the covenant, and read in the audience of the people: and they said, All that the LORD hath said will we do, and be obedient.

Exodus 24:8

8 And Moses took the blood, and sprinkled *it* on the people, and said, Behold the blood of the covenant, which the LORD hath made with you concerning all these words.

Hebrews 9:18

18 Whereupon neither the first *testament* was dedicated without blood.

Hebrews 9:19

19 For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the blood of calves and of goats, with water, and scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book, and all the people,

Exodus 24:9

9 Then went up Moses, and Aaron, Nadab, and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel:

Exodus 24:10

10 And they saw the God of Israel: and *there was* under his feet as it were a paved work of a sapphire stone, and as it were the body of heaven in *his* clearness.

Hebrews 10:19

19 Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus,

Hebrews 10:20

20 By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh;

Psalms 119:89

89 LAMED. For ever, O LORD, thy word is settled in heaven.

Psalms 12:6

6 The words of the LORD *are* pure words: *as* silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times.

Psalms 12:7

7 Thou shalt keep them, O LORD, thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever.

Hebrews 4:15

15 For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as *we are*, *yet* without sin.

Hebrews 4:16

16 Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

Leviticus 8:18

18 And he brought the ram for the burnt offering: and Aaron and his sons laid their hands upon the head of the ram.

Leviticus 8:19

19 And he killed *it*; and Moses sprinkled the blood upon the altar round about.

Leviticus 8:23

23 And he slew *it*; and Moses took of the blood of it, and put *it* upon the tip of Aaron's right ear, and upon the thumb of his right hand, and upon the great toe of his right foot.

Leviticus 8:24

24 And he brought Aaron's sons, and Moses put of the blood upon the tip of their right ear, and upon the thumbs of their right hands, and upon the great toes of their right feet: and Moses sprinkled the blood upon the altar round about.

Leviticus 8:30

30 And Moses took of the anointing oil, and of the blood which *was* upon the altar, and sprinkled *it* upon Aaron, *and* upon his garments, and upon his sons, and upon his sons' garments with him; and sanctified Aaron, *and* his garments, and his sons, and his sons' garments with him.

Hebrews 9:13

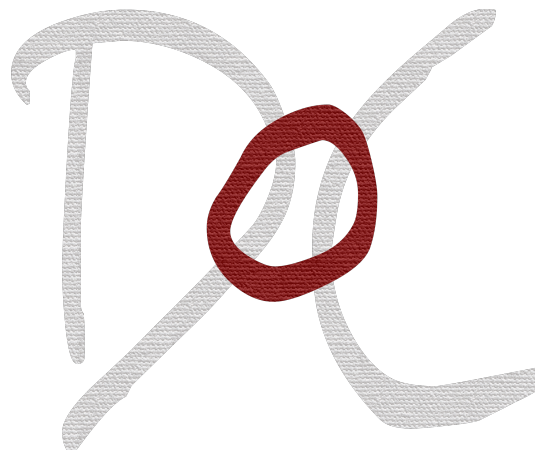
13 For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh:

Hebrews 9:14

14 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

Hebrews 9:15

15 And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions *that were* under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.
