Season 8 Episode 11

John 17:14

14 I have given them Your Word, and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.

John 14:10

10 Do you not believe that I *am* in the Father and the Father in Me? The Words that I speak to you I do not speak of Myself, but the Father who dwells in Me, He does the works.

John 3:34

34 For He whom God has sent speaks the Words of God, for God does not give the Spirit by measure.

John 7:16

16 Jesus answered them and said, My doctrine is not Mine, but His who sent Me.

1 Thessalonians 2:13

13 And for this cause we thank God without ceasing, that when you received *the* Word of hearing, of God, you welcomed *it as* the Word of God, not as a word of men, but *as* it is, truly *the* Word of God, which also effectually works in you who believe.

James 1:22

22 But become doers of the Word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.

Romans 2:13

13 For it is not the hearers of the Law who *are* just before God, but the doers of the Law will be justified.

John 10:32

32 Jesus answered them, I have shown you many good works from My Father; for which of these do you stone Me?

Romans 3:20

20 because by the works of the Law none of all flesh will be justified in His sight; for through the Law *is* the knowledge of sin.

Proverbs 16:2

2 All the ways of a man *are* clean in his own eyes, but Jehovah weighs the spirits.

2 Timothy 3:12

12 Yea, and all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will be persecuted.

1 Corinthians 15:33

33 Do not be deceived; evil companionships corrupt good habits.

Galatians 4:29

29 But then even as he born according to flesh persecuted him *born* according to the Spirit, so *it is* also now.

Genesis 3:15

15 And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed; He will bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel.

1 Peter 1:23

23 having been born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, through the living Word of God, and abiding forever.

Matthew 10:17

17 But beware of men, for they will deliver you up to the sanhedrins, and they will scourge you in their synagogues.

John 16:2

2 They shall put you out of *the* synagogue. But an hour is coming that everyone who kills you will think that he bears God service.

Hebrews 11:37

37 They were stoned, they were sawed in two, were tempted, were slain with the sword. They wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins, being destitute, afflicted, tormented.

Mark 13:9

9 But take heed to yourselves. For they shall deliver you up to sanhedrins, and in the synagogues you shall be beaten. And you shall be brought before rulers and kings for My sake, for a testimony against them.

Luke 21:13

13 And it shall return to you for a testimony.

Luke 21:14

14 Therefore settle *it* in your hearts not to meditate beforehand what you shall answer.

Luke 21:15

15 For I will give you a mouth and wisdom which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist.

John 7:7

7 The world cannot hate you, but it hates Me because I testify of it, that its works are evil.

1 Thessalonians 1:5

5 For our gospel did not come to you in word only, but also in power and in *the* Holy Spirit, and in much assurance, as you know what kind *of men* we were among you for your sake.

1 Thessalonians 1:6

6 And you became imitators of us and of the Lord, welcoming the Word in much affliction, with joy of *the* Holy Spirit,

Hebrews 10:32

32 But call to memory the former days, in which (after you were illuminated) you endured a great fight of afflictions,

1 Peter 4:13

13 but rejoice according as you are partakers of Christ's suffering, so that when His glory shall be revealed, you may be glad also with exceeding joy.

1 Peter 4:14

14 If you are reviled for *the* name of Christ, *you are* blessed, because the Spirit of God and of glory rests on you. Truly according to them, He is blasphemed, but according to you He is glorified.

1 Peter 4:15

15 But let none of you suffer as a murderer, or a thief, or an evildoer, or a meddler in the affairs of others.

1 Peter 4:16

16 But if *one suffers* as a Christian, let him not be ashamed, but let him glorify God because of this.

John 15:18

18 If the world hates you, you know that it hated Me before *it hated* you.

1 Peter 2:21

21 For you were not called to this? For Christ also suffered on our behalf, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps,

1 Peter 2:22

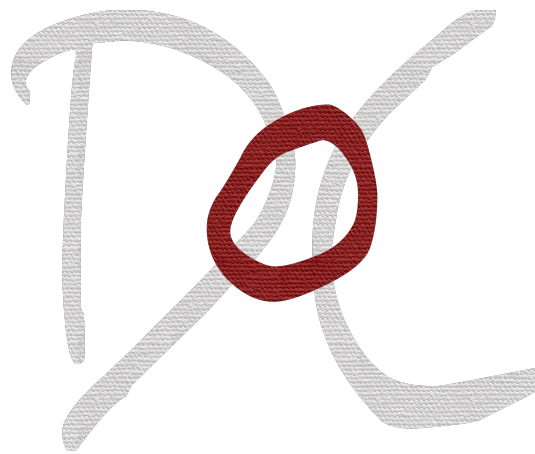
22 He who did no sin, nor was guile found in His mouth,

1 Peter 2:23

23 who when He was reviled did not revile in return. When He suffered, He did not threaten, but gave *Himself* up to Him who judges righteously.

Colossians 1:24

24 who now rejoice in my sufferings on your behalf, and I fill up the things lacking of the afflictions of Christ in my flesh, on behalf of His body, which *is* the church;
