Jesus Prophecies of the Beast

Season 8 Episode 9

John 17:12

12 While I was with them in the world, I kept them in Your name. Those that You have given Me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition, that the Scripture might be fulfilled.

Psalms 109:7

7 when he is judged, let him be condemned; and let his prayer become sin.

Psalms 109:8

8 Let his days be few; let another take his office.

Acts 1:20

20 For it is written in *the* Book of Psalms, "Let his estate become forsaken, and he not be living in it." And, "Let another take his overseership."

Psalms 41:9

9 Even a man, my friend, in whom I trusted, who ate of my bread, has lifted up *his* heel against me.

John 13:18

18 I do not speak of you all; I know whom I have chosen; but that the Scripture might be fulfilled, "He who eats bread with me has lifted up his heel against me."

Acts 20:28

28 Therefore take heed to yourselves, and to all the flock in which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to feed the church of God which He has purchased with *His* own blood.

Acts 20:29

29 For I know this, that after my departure grievous wolves shall enter in among you, not sparing the flock.

Acts 20:30

30 Also men shall arise from your own selves, speaking perverse things in order to draw disciples away after them.

2 Samuel 15:31

31 And *one* told David, saying, Ahithophel *is* among the conspirators with Absalom. And David said, O Jehovah, I pray You, turn the advice of Ahithophel to foolishness.

2 Samuel 17:23

23 And when Ahithophel saw that his counsel was not followed, even he saddled the ass and arose, and went home to his house, to his city, and put his household in order. And he hanged himself and died, and was buried in the tomb of his father.

2 Samuel 3:3

3 And his second was Chileab, of Abigail of Carmel, the former wife of Nabal. And the third *was* Absalom, the son of Maacah the daughter of Talmai king of Geshur.

Numbers 13:22

22 And they went up by the south and came to Hebron, where Ahiman, Sheshai, and Talmai, the sons of Anak *were*. (Now Hebron was built seven years before Zoan in Egypt.)

Luke 15:6

6 And when he comes home, he calls together *his* friends and neighbors, saying to them, Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep which was lost.

Luke 15:7

7 I say to you that likewise joy shall be in Heaven over one sinner who repents, more than over ninety-nine just persons who need no repentance.

Luke 15:8

8 Or what woman having ten drachmas, if she loses one drachma, does she not light a lamp and sweep the house, and seek carefully until she finds *it*?

Luke 15:9

9 And when she has found *it*, she calls *her* friends and her neighbors together, saying, Rejoice with me, for I have found the drachma which I had lost.

Luke 15:24

24 for this my son was dead and is alive again, he was lost and is found. And they began to be merry.

Luke 15:32

32 It was right that we should make merry and be glad, for this brother of yours was dead and is alive again; and was lost, and is found.

Matthew 10:1

1 And when He had called to *Him* His twelve disciples, He gave them authority over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease.

Matthew 10:2

2 And the names of the twelve apostles are these: First, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother; James *the son* of Zebedee and John his brother;

Matthew 10:3

3 Philip and Bartholomew; Thomas and Matthew the tax-collector; James *the son* of Alpheus, and Lebbeus, whose surname was Thaddeus;

Matthew 10:4

4 Simon the Canaanite, and Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed Him.

John 6:26

26 Jesus answered them and said, Truly, truly, I say to you, You seek Me not because you saw the miracles, but because you ate the loaves and were filled.

John 6:27

27 Do not labor *for* the food that perishes, but for that food which endures to everlasting life, which the Son of Man will give you. For God the Father sealed Him.

John 6:66

66 From this *time* many of His disciples went back into the things behind, and walked no more with Him.

John 6:67

67 Then Jesus said to the Twelve, Do you also wish to go away?

John 6:68

68 Then Simon Peter answered Him, Lord, to whom shall we go? You have *the* Words of eternal life.

Luke 22:31

31 And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan has desired you, that he may sift *you* as wheat.

Luke 22:32

32 But I have prayed for you, that your faith fail not. And when you are converted, strengthen your brothers.

Luke 22:33

33 And he said to Him, Lord, I am ready to go with You, both into prison and into death.

Luke 22:34

34 And He said, I say to you, Peter, the cock shall not crow this day before you shall deny knowing Me three times.

Proverbs 24:16

16 for a just one falls seven times, and rises up again; but the wicked shall fall into evil.

Matthew 16:15

15 He said to them, But who do you say I am?

Matthew 16:16

16 And Simon Peter answered and said, You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.

Matthew 16:17

17 Jesus answered and said to him, You are blessed, Simon, son of Jonah, for flesh and blood did not reveal *it* to you, but My Father in Heaven.

Matthew 16:18

18 And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and *the* gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

Matthew 16:19

19 And I will give the keys of the kingdom of Heaven to you. And whatever you may bind on earth shall occur, having been bound in Heaven, and whatever you may loose on earth shall occur, having been loosed in Heaven.

Matthew 16:20

20 Then He warned His disciples that they should tell no one that He was Jesus the Christ.

Matthew 16:21

21 From that time Jesus began to show His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things from the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised again the third day.

Matthew 16:22

22 Then Peter took Him and began to rebuke Him, saying, *God be gracious to You, Lord!* This shall never be to You.

Matthew 16:23

23 But He turned and said to Peter, Go, Satan! You are an offense to Me, for you do not savor the things that are of God, but those that are of men.

2 Thessalonians 2:3

3 Let not anyone deceive you by any means. For *that Day shall not come* unless there first comes a falling away, and the man of sin shall be revealed, the son of perdition,

1 Kings 10:14

14 And the weight of gold which came to Solomon in one year was six hundred sixty-six talents of gold,

Luke 22:3

3 And Satan entered into Judas, surnamed Iscariot, being of the number of the Twelve.

John 13:27

27 And after the morsel, then Satan entered into him. Then Jesus said to him, What you do, do quickly.

John 12:31

31 Now is *the* judgment of this world. Now shall the prince of this world be cast out.

Revelation 12:7

7 And there was war in Heaven. Michael and his angels warring against the dragon. And the dragon and his angels warred,

Revelation 12:8

8 but did not prevail. Nor was place found for them in Heaven any more.

Revelation 12:9

9 And the great dragon was cast out, the old serpent called Devil, and Satan, who deceives the whole world. He was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

Revelation 9:11

11 And they had a king over them, the angel of the bottomless pit, whose name in the Hebrew tongue *is* Abaddon, but in Greek his name *is* Apollyon.

Revelation 17:8

8 The beast that you saw was, and is not, and is about to ascend out of the abyss and go into perdition. And those dwelling on the earth will marvel, those whose names were not written in the Book of Life from the foundation of the world, when they behold the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.

Revelation 17:11

11 And the beast that was, and is not, even he is the eighth, and is of the seven, and goes into perdition.

John 17:12

12 While I was with them in the world, I kept them in Your name. Those that You have given Me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition, that the Scripture might be fulfilled.

Jeremiah 29:11

11 For I know the purposes which I am purposing for you, says Jehovah; purposes of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

Jeremiah 29:12

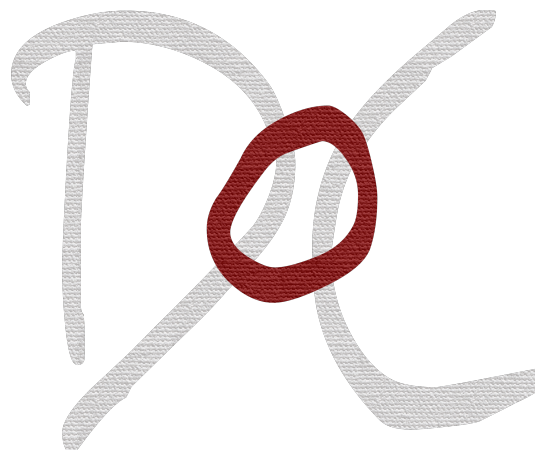
12 Then you shall call on Me, and you shall go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you.
